WHEN do I apply?

- The majority of boards and commissions do not have specific application deadlines, as vacancies can occur at any time. Therefore, we highly recommend that you submit your completed application and resume to our office once you have determined you would like to seek appointment. Once processed, your application will remain on file for at least a year, to be considered when there are openings.

Are there paid positions on state boards and commissions?
