



CWBA LIFT! FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why should I participate in CWBA Lift?

A: Participating in CWBA Lift offers you a unique opportunity to engage with a CWBA member or future member in a mentorship experience geared toward women lawyers and helping women advance in the legal field. CWBA participation and event attendance fulfills many of the CWBA Lift requirements.

Q: What are the time commitments?

A: The CWBA Lift is an approximate one-year commitment that begins once a mentor and a mentee are matched. Admissions occur on a rolling basis throughout the year. Mentors and mentees are eligible to receive up to 9 general CLE credits and 2 ethics credits as long as the program is completed within one year. CWBA Lift is overseen by the Colorado Attorney Mentoring Program and it has its own unique, CWBA-driven curriculum. The curriculum schedule is very flexible and can be modified to adapt to the schedules of mentor and mentee.

Q: What are the qualifications to participate?

A: To serve as a mentor, you must have been admitted to practice law in Colorado for at least five years, you must have an active license, be in good standing, and must submit a mentor application for approval. Mentees must be licensed, active Colorado lawyers, who are either practicing or intending to practice law in Colorado. Preference will be given to potential mentees within their first three years following admission to practice law in Colorado. Lawyers admitted on motion to the Colorado Bar who have been in practice three or more years in another jurisdiction can also participate in the mentoring program in their first year of practice in Colorado.

Q: I am a lawyer but not practicing- can I participate?

A: Yes, as long as you meet the requirements above.



Q: What if I have completed the Colorado Attorney Mentoring Program before?

A: If you are a mentor, you can still participate in the CWBA Lift program! If you have already completed the mentor application on the CAMP website, your application is valid for five years and you can contact CAMP and ask to become a CWBA Lift mentor.

Mentors are not limited on the number of times they can complete the program. Mentees can only complete the program once as a mentee, however.
